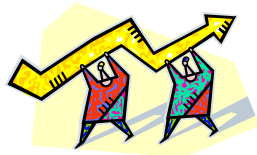




MOLE HILL NEWS

Childcare will be provided for this event so please call Angela at the office if you require this service: 604-687-1145.

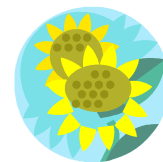

We need your help!

Many of you will have noticed the extensive work being done this summer, painting and repairing the wooden porches at Mole Hill.

We need your cooperation to preserve this work and prevent further damage. We ask that you elevate all planters by a minimum of 2 inches. This will provide airflow and help to alleviate the damage caused by leaving the planters directly on the wood surfaces.

Better yet, remove all planters over the winter months and replace them in the spring. Thanks for your cooperation!
